



RV Information - Onsite



The R.V. site at the Mt. McKinley Princess Lodge is located with other employee housing and is a 10 minute walk from the main lodge.

Amenities available with employee housing are available to employees living in the RV Park. This includes access to:

- Laundry buildings
- Altitude- team activity center with movie theater, games, internet access, TV's, DVD's and more!
- Hangar- employee lounge
- Fitness room & basketball hoop
- Shuttles to/from Talkeetna, Wasilla and Anchorage
- Discounted tours (space available)

Measurements: 48' x 18'

Cost: Free! In 2025, we are not charging for RV spots.

Move-in Date: Weather dependent. RV pads are a skim of gravel over silty clay and are thus subject to being very muddy, especially right after spring breakup.

Move-out Date: 1 day, 2 days after employment agreement ends with GM approval

Quiet Hours: 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

RV Requirements: Vehicles must be insured and properly maintained

Age Requirement: The minimum age to live on company property is 18.

Meals:

A meal program for employees staying at the MPL RV Park can be purchased via payroll deduction by the employee only.

- **Full Meal Plan:** \$10 per day, per person, and includes three meals at any of our employee dining venues.

FAQs:

Are the spots level?

For the most part, yes, but due to the makeup of the spots not being pavement, we are at the mercy of the ground thawing. We are not able to allow RVs to be present until the ground thaws as that creates damage to RVs, as well as causes them to sink in the quagmire.

Is there Wi-Fi or Cable at the RV Park?

Currently, there is limited Wi-Fi in the RV park and no cable available. Access to television is available to all employees at Altitude.

What type of jacks/blocks might be needed?

Standard blocks for RV anchoring are sufficient.

Can non-employee family or significant others live in the RV?

Yes. Employees can host up to three additional guests, but must have General Manager and Management approval. The employee is responsible for their guests' conduct (see conduct agreement). Please note that non-employees are not permitted in any of our housing spaces, like the dining facilities to eat, rec room, gym, etc.

Can I grill out by my RV?

Because of the windy and dry climate in Trapper Creek, we do not allow outdoor grilling in any of our housing facilities at any time.

Are campfires allowed?

No campfires or open flames of any kind allowed in housing.

Are pets allowed in the RV Park?

Yes. Employees can have a dog, cat or animal contained in an aquarium or cage in their RV in the RV Park. The employee is responsible for their animals' conduct and for cleaning up after them immediately (see pet agreement).

Can I put out a table and chairs?

While space is limited, you may put out a table and chairs to use. Be aware that the wind in Trapper Creek can be quite extreme, so you will want to plan to put these away on particularly blustery days.

Is smoking allowed in the RV Park?

Smoking is allowed in two designated areas throughout the housing facilities.
